MANIPUR CIVIL SERVICE/MANIPUR POLICE SERVICE EXAMINATION,
1997-98.

1. A combined competitive examination for recruitment of 9(nine) Manipur Civil Service Grade - II(Permanent) in the scale of pay Rs.2000-60-23-EL-3200-100-3500/-(Revised) and 11 (eleven) Manipur Police Service Grade-II(Permanent) in the scale of pay Rs.2000-60-2300-EB-75-3500/-(Revised) plus usual admissible allowances will be held by the Manipur Public Service Commission sometime in March, 1998. Programme and centre of the examination will be announced later. Out of 9 (nine) posts of MCS, 3 posts are reserved for ST and 1 post for SC. Out of 11(eleven) posts of MPS, 4 posts are reserved for ST and 1 for SC.
2. A candidate should be a Degree holder and should not be more than 35 years of age on the 1st March, 1997. Upper age limit may be relaxable for 5 years for SC/ST candidates.
3. In case of candidates who appeared at the MCS/MPS Examination - 1994, the age limit shall be suitably relaxed, as per direction of the Hon'ble Guahati High Court's order dated 11/11/97 in CR No. 56/96 and CR No. 81/96. Such candidates should clearly mentioned in BOLD letters on the top of the first page of application form their Roll No. in the MCS/MPS Examination, 1994 in the following words :-

*MCS/MPS EXAMINATION, 1994. ROLL NO. - - -
4. The Commission reserve the right to hold a Preliminary Examination to short list the candidates for the Main Examination on the lines of Civil Services Examination of Union Public Service Commission.
5. Candidates should defray their own expenses for collection of Admit Card for appearing in the Preliminary Examination/Main Examination/Personality Test.
6. The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of the candidate for admission to the Combined Written Examination shall be final and no candidate shall be admitted to the examination without the Admission Card issued by the Commission.
7. Application form and Instruction for Candidates containing rules and syllabus of the examination are obtainable on cash payment of Rs.5/- at the Commission's counter or by remitting the amount by M.O. to the undersigned with self-addressed stamped envelop of Rs.2/- of size 23x13 Cms. Request for forms and Instructions must specify the name of the examination, indicating two Optional subjects.
8. The number of posts of MCS/MPS is likely to be increased.
9. Closing date for issue and receipt of the Application Forms is 3 P.M. of 29-12-1997.
10. Selling of Application Forms will start from Monday, 24th November, 1997.
